### General Information

Training is undertaken at Liverpool John Lennon Airport using a PA38 Piper Tomahawk or a PA28 Piper Cherokee/Warrior aircraft. Liverpool John Lennon Airport provides an ideal training environment, giving students the opportunity to fly in and out of an international airport with 24 hr operation and Air Traffic Control. With both primary and secondary radar all instrument procedures can be flown at Liverpool either under simulated or genuine instrument meteorological conditions.

### Basic Package

The basic IMC Rating package includes the following:

- 13.5 hours dual training in PA38 Tomahawk or PA28 Piper Cherokee/Warrior in simulated IMC conditions, plus 1.5 hours for the IMC Flight Test
- 6 hours dual training in the Aerosoft 200 Flight Simulator
- All landing and navigation charges incurred
- Pre and post-flight briefings for each lesson
