Dear Pieter,

I am writing to you to confirm that Liverpool John Lennon is now approved to accept accompanied Cats, Dogs and Ferrets travelling to the UK under the Pet Travel Scheme (PETS) and Ravenair are approved as the authorised PETS checker at Liverpool John Lennon in accordance with the conditions in the signed agreement.

Each carrier who wishes to transport Cats, Dogs and/or Ferrets into Liverpool John Lennon must first agree a Required Method of Operation (RMOP) with the local AHVLA Office and have a Service Level Agreement with Ravenair. All animals must be transported in accordance with conditions agreed in the RMOP.

Please note that a Cat, Dog or Ferret that fails the required check upon arrival at Liverpool John Lennon can be held in the approved facility for a maximum of 4 hours. In the event that an animal will not become PETS compliant within this period the animal must be re-exported or moved to an approved Quarantine Kennel, a list of which can be found at the following web page:
