

Part-FCL CPL(A) Modular Course (Rev062018 Eff 12Jan18)

Pre-entry Requirements

Applicants wishing to take the Part-FCL CPL(A) course must meet the following requirements before commencement of the course:

- be the holder of a PPL(A) issued in accordance with ICAO Annex 1.
- have completed 150 hours flight time as a pilot (200 hours required for licence issue).
- hold a Multi-Engine Piston (Land) Rating.
- have complied with all Part-FCL pre-requisites.

Ground Examinations

Applicants should have successfully completed the theoretical knowledge examinations as set out in Part-FCL. The Skill Test should be completed within the period of validity of a pass in all theoretical examinations.

Ravenair do not at this time provide a ground studies course for the CPL/ATPL examinations, however we recommend Bristol Groundschool which specialise in these ground studies.

Course Details

The modular course at Ravenair consists of 25 hours flying, which will include 5 hours on a complex aircraft. The training takes place from Liverpool John Lennon Airport on PA38 Piper Tomahawk or PA28 Piper Cherokee aircraft, with the requirement for complex time being fulfilled on our twin engine PA34-200T Piper Seneca aircraft.

Costs

The cost of the 25-hour course is available on our current pricelist. This cost includes all landing, navigation charges and VAT. In addition to the cost of the course, the applicant must pay the fee for the Skill Test directly to the CAA, and aircraft hire for the duration of the Skill Test at the solo hourly rate, plus landing and navigation charges incurred during the test. PA38/PA28 time can be exchanged for Seneca time at an additional cost, see our current pricelist.

For the basic package, the cost of the course is payable 100% in advance. A service charge of 3% is charged for credit card payments. (Amex & Diners are not accepted.) No surcharge for debit card payments. See website for full Terms and Conditions. E&OE.
