**APPENDIX 2****AIRCRAFT SEARCH DECLARATION**

In accordance with the Chapter 3 of the EU 2015/1998, CD 2015/8005 and UK SCD (A) 1/2018, all aircraft within the Critical Part must be subjected to an aircraft search by appropriately vetted and trained personnel in accordance with Chapter 11.2 requirements of the EU and UK regulatory requirements. Areas to be searched are in accordance with the CD 2015/8005 Attachment 3 – A and UK SCD (A) 1/2018 Part B.

Aircraft security search list of areas to be examined:

An aircraft security search shall consist of an examination of all of the following areas, when they are accessible without the use of tools, keys, stairs or other aids, and without breaking seals:

- overhead bins;
- cupboards and storage compartments, including crew storage areas;
- toilet compartments;
- galley areas;
- seat pockets;
- areas under seats, between seats and between the seat and the wall;
- flight deck, if left unattended;
- aircraft hold;
- items contained within the hold;
- aircraft service panels and service hatches;
- wheel wells;
- between 10% of lifejacket pouches.
